Geo Smart Decisions is fully committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. This privacy notice (and any documents referred to within it) sets out how we look after and protect the personal information you provide to us. This includes what you tell us about yourself, what we learn by having you as a customer, and the choices you give us about what marketing communications you want us to send you.

How we collect your data

Geo Smart Decisions collects data about you. This includes but is not limited to your name, the organisation you work for, and your professional business contact details such as e-mail address, telephone numbers and postal address as well as information you provide to us through our website contact form and other correspondence.

We collect this data when you:

- contact us on behalf of your organisation to request information about our services;
- engage our services on behalf of your organisation;
- meet professionally with a member of the Geo Smart Decisions team and exchange contact information;
- visit our web site and provide information on our web site contact form.

You will be asked whether you agree to the use of cookies on our website. Cookies are simple text files that are stored on the device you used to access the website by a website's server. These files cannot be used to identify the visitor personally. They are used on the Geo Smart Decisions Limited website to capture statistics on usage.

The following types of cookies are used on the Geo Smart Decisions Limited website:

- **Session Cookies:** These basic cookies are used to carry out the essential functions on websites, such as website to identify you as a user, remember you from page to page within the website and maintaining log in details for the session or a transaction. These expire as soon as you close your browser, or after a short period of typically 20 minutes of inactivity.
- **Persistent Cookies:** These are the small text files that are dropped into the cookies folder of your web browser by the website. They can contain information to record specific browsing information such as how you reached the website, the pages you view, options you select, and the path you have taken through the site. These typically remain in your cookies folder.

The visitor can choose to restrict cookies through their browser settings at any time.
